



Veterans' MATES Clinical Audit - Patient Review

10 ACRRM PDP points per topic completed

Promoting Quality Use of Medicines for Veterans

GPs registered in the ACRRM Professional Development Program that complete the current Veterans' MATES topic and complete the essential requirements of a clinical audit, are eligible for 10 PDP points.

What do I need to do?

Each Clinical Audit - Patient Review involves completing one Veterans' MATES topic. You can undertake the current topic from the Veterans' MATES Program for which you are managing veterans selected in that topic. You must complete the topic to obtain 10 PDP points.

To claim PDP points for a topic, you must complete the following steps:

- 1 Review the feedback on specific patients included in the Veterans' MATES topic sent via eDelivery or in the post.
- 2 Review the 'Key Points' on the therapeutic brief. These are the learning objectives for each topic.
- 3 Consider the information in the therapeutic brief and its relevance to your patients.
- 4 Conduct a review of your own practice against the information in the therapeutic brief.
- 5 Consider how the 'Key Points' in the therapeutic brief might apply to the selected patients. This will involve reviewing the medical notes of these patients.
- 6 Follow up and review selected patients after reading the therapeutic brief and considering baseline data. This may involve annotating case notes and contacting individual patients to schedule consultations.
- 7 Evaluate and document your learning by:
 - (1) **Keeping a record** of the patients identified in the Veterans' MATES topic.
 - (2) **Recording** changes made to their management and patient outcomes.
- 8 Complete the Response Form. For eDelivery participants use the unique link provided to submit online. For postal participants return the form in the prepaid envelope provided.

How do I register and obtain ACRRM PDP points?

Return your response form in the prepaid envelope OR use the unique link provided via eDelivery to submit online. Ensure you include your ACRRM membership number. Please note: the program is available only to GPs that manage veterans selected in Veterans' MATES topics.
