## Self-recorded Logged CPD Activity


### Promoting Quality Use of Medicines for Veterans

GPs who receive and complete the current Veterans' MATES topic and complete the required steps can claim logged CPD activity points as a self-recorded activity.\*

### What do I need to do?

Each activity involves completing a Veterans' MATES topic. You can complete the current topic from the Veterans' MATES program to self-record and claim logged CPD activity points. **Two points per each hour spent** on an activity to a maximum of 30 points are available.

### To claim CPD points for a topic, you must complete the following steps:

- 
- 1 Review the feedback on specific patients included in the Veterans' MATES topic sent via eDelivery or in the post.
  - 2 Review the 'Key Points' on the therapeutic brief. These are the learning objectives for each topic.
  - 3 Consider the information in the therapeutic brief and its relevance to your patients.
  - 4 Conduct a review of your own practice against the information in the therapeutic brief.
  - 5 Consider how the 'Key Points' in the therapeutic brief might apply to the selected patients. This will involve reviewing the medical notes of these patients.
  - 6 Follow up and review selected patients after reading the therapeutic brief and considering baseline data. This may involve annotating case notes and contacting individual patients to schedule consultations.
  - 7 Evaluate and document your learning by:
    - (1) **Keeping a record** of the patients identified in the Veterans' MATES topic.
    - (2) **Recording** changes made to their management and patient outcomes.
  - 8 Complete the Response Form. For eDelivery participants use the unique link provided to submit online. For postal participants return the form in the prepaid envelope provided.

### How do I register for CPD points?

If you wish to receive a certificate of completion, return your response form in the prepaid envelope or use the unique link provided via eDelivery to submit online.

\* Only available to GPs who are managing veterans selected in Veterans' MATES topic.
